What do we do?

Sunderland Youth Council supports young people to attend meetings and conferences locally and nationally to ensure their views are taken into consideration when decisions are being made that could affect their lives.

Sunderland Youth Council also provides opportunities to meet and make new friends to discuss issues that matter to young people in Sunderland.

Nationally we continue to have our views heard with members of Sunderland Youth Council attending the House of Commons debate every year, and attending national events across the country.

Every year Sunderland Youth Council support a campaign that is voted for by young people from across the city at the Annual Young People's State of the City Debate. In 2019 young people voted for 'Protect our Environment'.
